## Statement on the RoHS 3 (Restriction of Hazardous substances) directive 2011/65/EC

Date: 16/03/2026

In relevance to the regulatory requirements of the EU directive mentioned above, we hereby state:

- The EU Directive **2011/65 /EU RoHS 3** as amended by the (EU) 2025/18021, 2025/23632, and 2025/23643 serves to restrict and regulate the use of certain hazardous substances in **electrical and electronic equipment**.

- The articles such as CONEL CONNECT COPPER pipe connectors (fittings) and CONEL STREAM valves that we offer and deliver ready to use and process to the market are not electrical and electronic equipment.

- The RoHS 3 regulatory requirements under the EU directive 2011/65/EU therefore are not applicable to our products.

- We would like to declare that for technical reasons the alloy component lead (EC: 231-100-4, CAS: 7439-92-1) is contained in our copper alloys (gunmetal and brass) in a mass concentration of more than 0.1%.


- All CONEL fittings made of copper and copper alloys meet the national and European hygienic and health requirements of the UBA list ("Acceptance List of Metallic Materials / 4MS") for products in contact with drinking water and are permanently monitored by independent accredited institutes.

- Lead is firmly bound as an alloy component in our products, so that no exposures are to be expected when used as intended.

- We have no indication that the above declared substance can impair the safe use of our products for the intended purpose. Please follow our corresponding instructions for use and installation for the respective product.
